Jeanette suggests that h and IT uses the money that they see fit. Dave D states this area body needs to relieve these gentlemen of holding this money and the responsibility. Katie O reports that last time she was doing activities we didn't have \$2,000 to do camp o'bannon. Dave D said if we don't have a budget we don't need \$2,000 yet. Jeanette said that's a good point Dave, We wouldn't need to know until after the next area and see if the area is able to help.</p> <p>Carey H asks if they make over \$2,000 they have to give the overage to the area? Dave C said that the policy said that we can't have \$2,000 in the account.
