Jeanett reports this is a valid grievance , also maybe we need to come up with a new order form with the 10% deduction but with Doug not being here it is hard to resolve, Garret reports we do have records of the merchandise / literature sold this evening.

Blake reports it's really easy if we get the right system in place we just need to implement the new policy . We have to put it into action because if we don't it's going to be the same issues that we have continued to have.

Chad reports we need Doug here to set this in place.

Heather M reports when they went to the bank there is a bank acct set up for activities and for literature and merchandise.

Dave Diley makes a motion for 5125 to purchase a POS system that Bradon recommends that we need to get done what we need done .

14 for the motion . 0 against 1 abstained . motion passed.

Justin G - when he goes to regional and they ask him to bring back motions to homegroups are we supposed to ask the homegroups to vote for people and positions that they have zero knowledge about. Or is he allowed to vote for the area body because he has knowledge of these members and their positions. Dave C reports that because we voted Justin into this position that he should be trusted with the voting for our area body, Chad asked we don't need to vote on this right ? no one objected to this.

Justin asks do we want to vote on this cash app? Mattie reports that there has been a 71 % increase in payments since this has been implemented and that he finds this impressive.

Angel M- 5-2-25 reports that someone from Stantonville requests that we donate 10

basic texts. 14, unanimous.

Chad reports we need to make a list for what we need Doug to complete from today's meeting , 2 welcome packets , and 10 basic texts.

Janice D- reports that the Ties that Bind are in need of literature. She is wondering if groups can assist with the money because they don't know what happened with the meeting money from before? Chad reports they can donate 5 how and whys. Jeanette reports that Love Ya Lots can probably donate 5 of the books that real deal doesn't vote

Dave C reports he will donate 3 basic texts and 3 how it works and why. He also thinks the meeting money got packed away when he moved. Mattie is asking that we do a 7th tradition for the meeting Jeanette asks what else do you need? Janice said just about everything . Chad informs Janice that homegroups will vote on assistance.
